OBJECTIVE 1:	The aim of the course is to improve competence in understanding human sexuality as an integral part of the functioning of the human body, both in the biological and psychosocial sense. It covers the principles of diagnostic procedures and interventions towards a person with sexual problems, as well as acquiring knowledge and skills about treatment methods used in sexology. Participants will verify their personal attitudes towards sexuality. They will gain knowledge about the challenges and dilemmas faced by contemporary sexology.	
OBJECTIVE 2:	The aim of the classes is to acquire knowledge about control and fertility disorders, including diagnostic methods and multifaceted treatment. Course participants will acquire knowledge about modern assisted reproductive techniques (ART).
